The Auxiliaries are busy making masks and raising funds online for RSL DefenceCare. We can also take heart that during the pandemic five new Auxiliaries have commenced in regional and Sydney metropolitan areas.

There is no doubt that the extended lockdown has been difficult, especially for those members in COVID-19 hotspot areas. Hard decisions have had to be taken, including suspending commemorative services and delaying the State Congress until December. The withdrawal from Afghanistan has added an extra dimension of anxiety and unease, especially among younger veterans.
